





BREAKDOWN OF 2020 REVENUES BY BUSINESS

MORE SUSTAINABILITY



Hyperion: a flagship project exemplifying the Group's low-carbon strategy

The Hyperion building is France's tallest wood-built residential tower, featuring 304 HyperMOB® wall modules produced by our subsidiary Savare, which is specialised in the manufacture of timber-framed walls, roof trusses and wooden beams, resulting in a carbon footprint that is 45% smaller than for a conventional building.

_ B3 Ecodesign: an upcycling technique

B3 Ecodesign (acquired by Eiffage Construction in 2019) is specialised in modular construction using repurposed shipping containers to create sustainable, low-carbon designer structures with applications in housing, commercial property and public facilities. The company's solutions deliver a combination of cost-effectiveness, short lead times and custom adaptations to meet customer requirements.

_ LaVallée: sustainable city demonstrator

The LaVallée ecodistrict in Châtenay-Malabry showcases the Group's innovative solutions in the area of low-carbon design, the circular economy, urban nature and emerging uses. This 213,000 sq.m. development features an environmentally-friendly urban heating network.

MORE LOCAL



— High school in Clermont-Ferrand: maximum use of locally-available resources

The Regional Council of Auvergne-Rhône-Alpes was interested in building a wood and straw high school that would deliver a combination of "positive energy" performance and a minimal carbon impact, with the aim of achieving E4C2 certification.

Its structure consists of glulam pillars and beams, coupled with timber-framed walls.

The wood, sourced locally in the Massif Central, was machined in workshops set up by Savare, providing local employment opportunities.



REIMS (51)

Sofilo

A new neighbourhood is being developed on the outskirts of Reims at a 1.5 ha brownfield site previously occupied by Sofilo. The site contains 350 housing units and a student housing facility, overlooking a green space, two public squares and a new road. This planning operation is being handled a joint planning structure formed by Eiffage Aménagement and SEM Agencia.





PONTOISE (95)

Cour des marchandises

This brownfield project to regenerate the area is a mixed-use development featuring, in particular, a Cazam® upscale retirement home.

— We have engaged with emerging social issues through a host of innovations intended to foster "community spirit", including the Cocoon'Ages® multi-generational housing concept and the Cazam® serviced retirement homes.

A helping hand for buyers

Because buying a property is a big commitment, and marks the start of a long-term relationship, we provide a range of innovative support services, including an electronic signing process for booking contracts, the "Atelier by Eiffage" solution and an interactive online service that helps buyers picture themselves in their future homes.

SAINT-OUEN (93)

Athletes' village

This 53,000 sq.m. site is a showcase for green construction techniques that blend wood and low-carbon concrete. For the first time, the legacy of the Olympic Games is to include a whole city neighbourhood rather than just a collection of housing units, complete with locations for artists, shared and public spaces and areas of greenery.



"Atelier by Eiffage": move in with less stress

We set up these mobile workshops next to our developments all over France, to help new residents move in smoothly. At each site, they are greeted by an assistant who can arrange a host of local services, including help selecting a removals firm, odd jobs, a tool library, a package reception service, etc.



MONTIGNY-LÈS-METZ (57)

Lizé district

Eiffage Immobilier is building 286 housing units, including a Cocoon'Ages® multi-generational housing facility, offices, shops and a small childcare nursery in the future Lizé neighbourhood. Eiffage Aménagement has chosen a 9 ha military brownfield site for this eco-district (spanning 57,000 sq.m.), where it intends to lead by example, with a focus on energy performance.

VARSOVIE (POLAND)

Białostocka

Property development operations are gathering momentum in Poland, with nearly 300 housing units booked and 3 new programmes launched in Wroclaw and Warsaw.





At Eiffage Construction, we harness our capacity for innovation to benefit customers and the environment alike. A custom solution is developed for each project, in synergy with the various Eiffage businesses.

A comprehensive, integrated offer

In the new-build and renovation markets alike, we provide custom offers to our private and public sector customers, covering all stages of their project, from design to handover and maintenance.

Rolling out a range of innovative solutions

— Sharing our customers' commitment to environmental protection, we are constantly developing innovative construction techniques. We have turned to wooden construction to enhance our traditional construction methods, and use a combination of industrialised production and modular construction to minimise nuisances and optimise construction times.

A new lease of life for heritage properties

— Our teams of renovation specialists apply their technical expertise to ambitious projects such as the Fresk building, featuring extensive redevelopment of a 21,500 sq.m. building in Issy-les-Moulineaux. Operating through our subsidiary Pradeau Morin, we refurbish exceptional historic buildings, such as the ceremonial courtyard at the Hôtel National des Invalides.

CHÂTENAY-MALABRY (92)

Lidl head office

Eiffage Construction is building Lidl's new head office in the LaVallée mixed development zone located in Châtenay-Malabry. The programme is being coordinated by Eiffage Aménagement. Spanning 40,000 sq.m., the site will house the Lidl campus and its 1,100 employees, a 3,000 sq.m. Lidl supermarket and 860 parking spaces. Eiffage Énergie Systèmes and Goyer, both subsidiaries of the Eiffage Group, are lending their expertise to this development.



Performance-enhancing digital solutions

BIM (Building Information Modeling) and our Cockpit room are collaborative tools that enable us to provide our customers with optimal project management services. They can be used to assemble and frame the dialogue between the various stakeholders at each stage of the project, and enable real-time exchange of all types of data relating to the works.





CYSOING (59)

Retirement home Résidence de la Pévèle

This retirement home. featuring wooden construction elements, solar panels and prefabricated modules, will be the first to obtain E3C1 certification under the E+C- (energy efficiency and carbon footprint) scheme.



CAEN (14)

Caen Normandie university hospital

Our extensive and well-recognised expertise in the construction of healthcare facilities enabled us to secure a reconstruction contract for buildings that will not be open to the public at Caen's university hospital. The contract covers 40,000 sq.m. to be developed for the hospital's logistics, administrative, pharmaceutical and biology departments. This environmentallyfriendly programme will belong to the next generation of "smart" hospitals, and be a key factor in the well-being of patients and healthcare providers.



BRUXELLES (BELGIUM)

Media Square

RTBF's new head office, spanning almost 40,000 sq.m., will house the staff of Belgium's state-run audiovisual group in a new building that meets very high energy performance standards.

We renovated the coronary angiography room to accommodate a new medical imaging device.

LILLE (59)

Lille citadel

The military buildings, hall and courtyard are being refitted as they were in the 19th century, while also being adapted to accommodate modern-day recreational uses.



ORANGE (84)

Car dealership

We renovated an old retail property to create a 1,000 sq.m. car dealership, adding a 1,500 sq.m. car park, a car wash station and a 600 sq.m. showroom.

Participating in the circular economy

Cement recarbonation using recycled aggregates from deconstructed buildings, upcycling of materials and old fittings in conjunction with the **RéaVie** association, provision of pooled inter-site services with the **Noé platform**, etc. We encourage the development of circular economy solutions and their integration into our operations to help relieve pressure on natural resources.





Developing a mix of low-carbon materials

Biosourced and geosourced materials such as wood, hemp or straw, and new low-carbon concrete ranges... Prompted by the extent of the impact of materials on a programme's footprint, we have developed a pool of low-carbon materials suitable for different uses

Industrialising the construction process

We are harnessing factory-based modular construction methods to optimise lead times and reduce nuisances and site waste. For instance, we produce timber-framed walls (MOB, BioMOB and HyperMOB) with our subsidiary Savare, and pre-finished HVA Concept® bathrooms and their timber-framed low-carbon alternative (Wa'ood® bathrooms).

Imagining cost-effective and efficient concepts and solutions

We innovate and change our building methods to enhance the range of products and services we offer and are able to provide structures that combine modern-day architecture, efficient energy performance, optimal lead times and affordability. The **Ekohom** and **H2CO** housing concepts are good examples of this, as are the **B3 Ecodesign** modular building solutions, which use repurposed shipping containers.
